The Health Scholarship was established to support Lu Mien students committed to pursuing careers in the health field. This award aims to increase Lu Mien representation within healthcare, ensuring that the community has a strong and informed voice in medical spaces. By empowering future health professionals, the scholarship seeks to promote culturally responsive care and improve health outcomes for the Lu Mien community.

Award Amount: \$1000. Number of recipients awarded is dependent on funds available.

Eligibility

- **Lu Mien post-secondary/college students currently enrolled or majoring in a health professions program.**
- Have maintained a **minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.**
- Health sciences include, but are not limited to nursing, physical therapy, respiratory therapy, medicine, dentistry, occupational therapy, speech therapy, psychology/psychiatry, optometry, veterinary, radiologic technology (x-ray tech, ultrasound tech, etc.)
- Previous recipients of the award are ineligible to apply.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

Submit one (1) letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, community leader, supervisor, or employer. Please ask your recommender to address the following:

- Years of acquaintance
- Your strengths and qualifications
- A personal evaluation of your academic/leadership skills
- Illustrate your potential
- Any substantial information he/she wishes to provide us to aid our selection process

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

Submit an official transcript with completion of spring session and stamped school seal and/or signature. Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.

RESUME

Submit your resume that includes work, community, school activities, awards, etc. This will serve to enhance our understanding of your experience and accomplishments.
